INVITATION TO SERVE AS AN AUDIT COMMITTEE MEMBER

In terms of section 76(4) and 77 of the Public Finance Management Act (PFMA) read with chapter 3 of Treasury Regulations, applications are invited from the interested independent and suitably qualified persons to serve on the Audit Committee of the National School of Government for a period of three (3) years.

Requirements: Applicants should:

- (a) have relevant degree in Accounting/Auditing/Risk/Legal/Information Technology
- (b) have a relevant postgraduate qualification (e.g., CA(SA), CIA, LLB, etc) which will be an added advantage.
- (c) have at least 10 years' experience in: Accounting/Auditing/Legal/Information Technology/Risk and Compliance.
- (d) have knowledge of PFMA, Modified Cash Standards, GRAP or GAAP, IT Governance
- (e) be independent and knowledgeable of the position as Audit Committee member, and
- (f) have at least 3-5 years' experience of serving in Audit Committees, Boards of Directors, or similar committee in the Public Sector.
- (g) Membership with a professional body will be an added advantage.

The applicant is required to display and be committed to the following attributes: Integrity, dedication, understanding public sector business and controls, good communication skills, inquisitiveness, and independent judgment.

Responsibilities: Execution of roles and responsibilities as outlined in chapter 3 of Treasury Regulations issued in terms of the PFMA as well as the Audit Committee Charter. The Audit Committee will report to the Executive Authority and Accounting Officer of the National School of Government.

The Audit Committee shall meet **at least four (4) times** per financial year.

Remuneration is paid per Treasury Regulations par. 202.2 or 20.2.3

Applications must be accompanied by a comprehensive curriculum vitae as well as certified copies of qualifications and identity document.
