



Supply Chain Management in the Public Service

PURPOSE

To develop public sector Supply Chain Management knowledge, skills and values as espoused in the Constitution (Section 217). The programme is aimed at supporting service delivery and alleviate adverse supply chain management related findings in departments and entities.
