

IMPORTANT NOTICE

2025/26 SELF - PACED eLEARNING COURSES STATUS UPDATE

This notice provides important updates on the Paid-for Self-paced eLearning Courses, including the Compulsory induction Programme (Levels 6-12), for the 2025/26 financial-academic year

Closure of New Enrolments.

New enrolments for the 2025/26 courses are now closed until 15 April 2026.

All current online courses will **close on 31 March 2026**, therefore new participants will not have sufficient time to complete the course before the closure date. Acceptance of new registrations at this stage of the financial year would create unnecessary financial implications for both the departments and learners.

Course Closure and Re-registration Requirements

The **2025/26 courses will close on 31 March 2026.**

Learners who have **not completed their courses by this date** will be automatically removed when the system closes. They must **re-register in the new financial year**, noting that **applicable course fees will apply.**

Opening of New Registrations

Registrations for the new financial-academic year will **open on 15 April 2026.**

A registration link will be circulated once the platform reopens for new enrolments.

Learners Who Did Not Start the Course

Learners registered for the 2025/26 CIP course who never started (i.e., received login credentials but **did not log in**) will be allowed to start the course in the new financial-academic year without paying again, provided their booking is not older than two consecutive financial years.

However, **learners who logged in and started but failed to complete by 31 March 2026** will be removed from the system and are required to **rebook and start the course from the beginning**, with standard fees applying.

Departments are encouraged to **review their bookings** and identify learners in the **“not started” category**, as they will still have an opportunity to complete the course in the new year.
