



AVOIDING IRREGULAR, FRUITLESS AND WASTEFUL EXPENDITURE (SALARY LEVELS 9 -16)

The purpose of this workshop is to empower public officials with skills required for managing government expenditure in order to prevent irregular, unauthorised and fruitless and wasteful expenditure.

TARGET GROUP
